JUDGMENT	

This action came for trial to a jury of six on March 2, 2020. The issues were duly tried and the jury of six deliberated and rendered their verdict on March 17, 2020. The verdict was accepted by the Court and announced in open Court with Plaintiff’s counsel and Plaintiff present, as well as Defendant’s counsel and Defendant present, and thereafter the jury was discharged. The jury rendered a verdict in favor of each Defendant Aronoff, Defendant Hollander, and Defendant Smith on Plaintiffs’ breach of fiduciary duty claim. .


